The purpose of this worksheet is to help teachers plan and organise core and fringe vocabulary for specific activities, ensuring that AAC tools are tailored to meet the learning needs of students.

Objective:	(define the specific goals of the lesson activity, e.g. "Teach basic emotions")

1- Selection and Prioritisation of vocabulary words:

The following criteria can help in the selection of relevant and impactful words for the activity before implementing:

1. Relevance:

- Is this word central to the activity or lesson goal?
- o Will this word enhance communication during the activity?

2. Transferability:

- Can this word be used in other contexts or activities?
- 3. Student Familiarity:
 - o Is the student already familiar with this word?
 - Will introducing this word build on their current knowledge?

4. Manageability:

Is the number of selected words manageable for the student and the AAC tool?
