



The black raven, put back in order!

Activity sheet

- **Target group:** 6+ years old
- **Duration:** 30 minutes
- **Material needed:**
 - pictograms cards
 - sentences form text level 1 and Level 2
 - a notebook or a sheet
- **Key competence:** Literacy

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

This activity is relevant to develop:

- activation of the memory by re-writing the story by associating pictograms and text
- reading & comprehension
- work together



IMPLEMENTATION

- 1/ Gather the children around a table, two by two.
- 2/ Give 5 lines of pictograms and 5 sentences to each pair.
- 3/ Ask them to find the right association
- 4/ Gather all the pairs to create the story and read it.

POTENTIALS FOR AAC SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

This activity use AAC tools as pictograms cards. It helps to manipulate the cards with the hands and fingers. Either pupils can have plastic cards, either they can print and glue them on their life book. It is a sensorial activity.

If they can, students work two by two in order to discuss, confront their ideas.

This activity helps to express ideas, opinions and then helps to read.

TO GO FURTHER

Pupils who can write can re-write the story with their own words.
