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## HOW TO READ THIS BOOK?

### Read aloud

Each pupil is assigned one character and reads when their colour appears.

You can find the colour code on the next pages.

### Individual reading

You can choose to display the story on a digital device, or to print the PDF version of the story.



### LOUD

Read the sentence as loud as you can.

## DISPLAY THE BOOK

We recommend displaying the book **page by page**.

To ensure everyone can read the text, we suggest showing the book on a large screen.

The level is designed to encourage active participation of the readers.

A good girl who brings food to her grandmother.

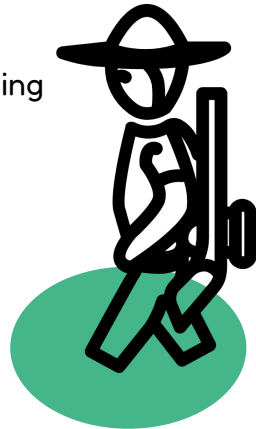
### **Wolf**

A bad wolf who wants to eat Little Red Riding Hood and her grandmother.



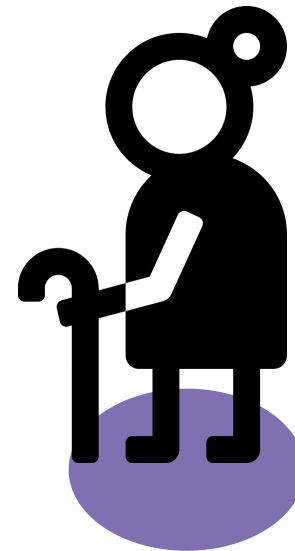
### **Hunter**

Little Red Riding Hood's grandmother. She is sick and lives in a house in the forest.

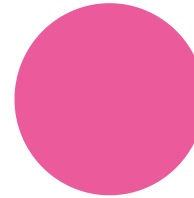


## Colour code

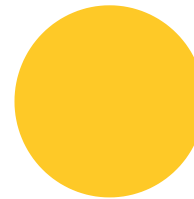
The coloured pages stand for the **characters**.



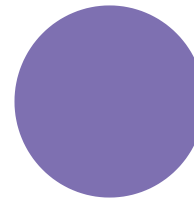
This symbols represents the **narrator**.



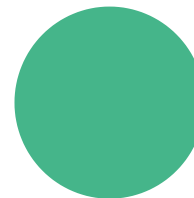

She brought a basket full of food with her.

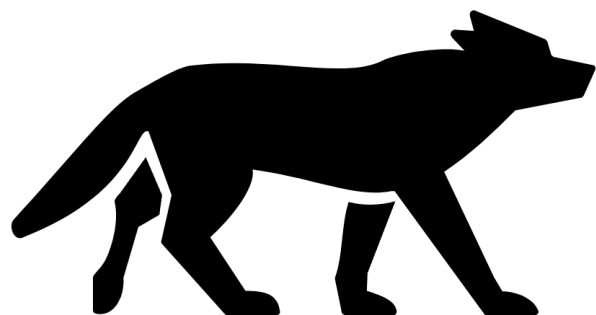
On the way, she met a dangerous wolf.

forest."

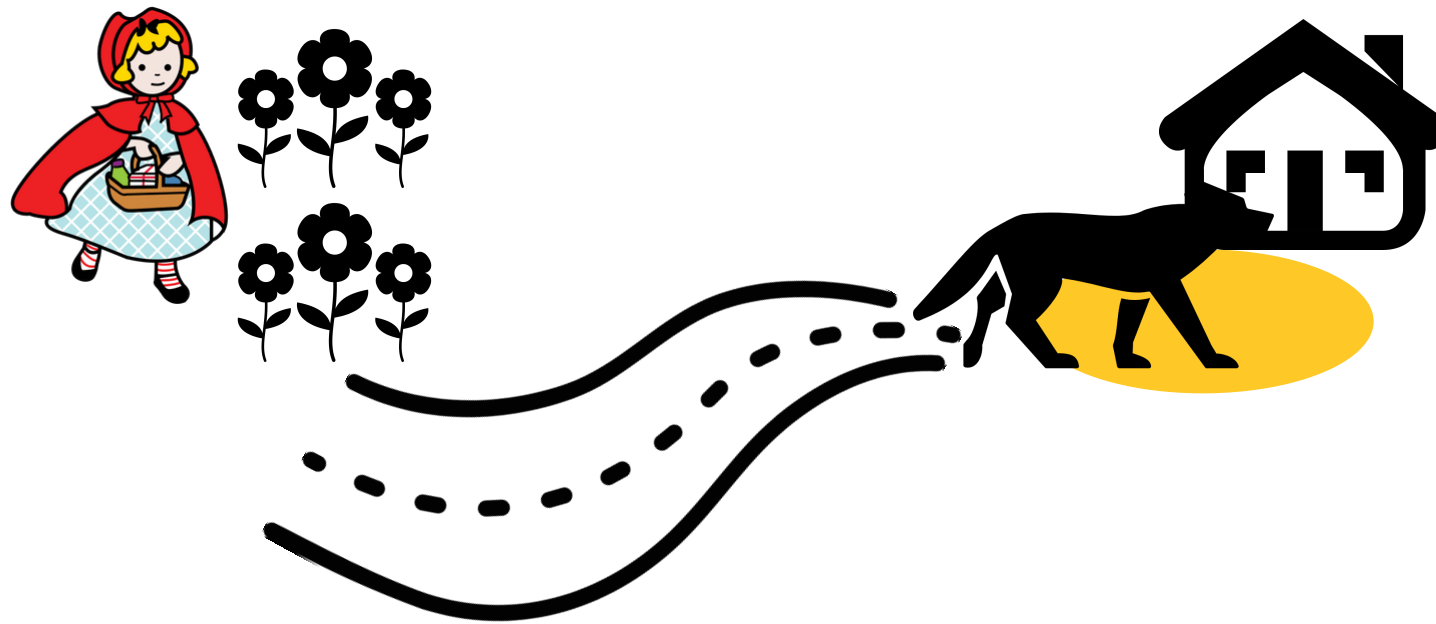






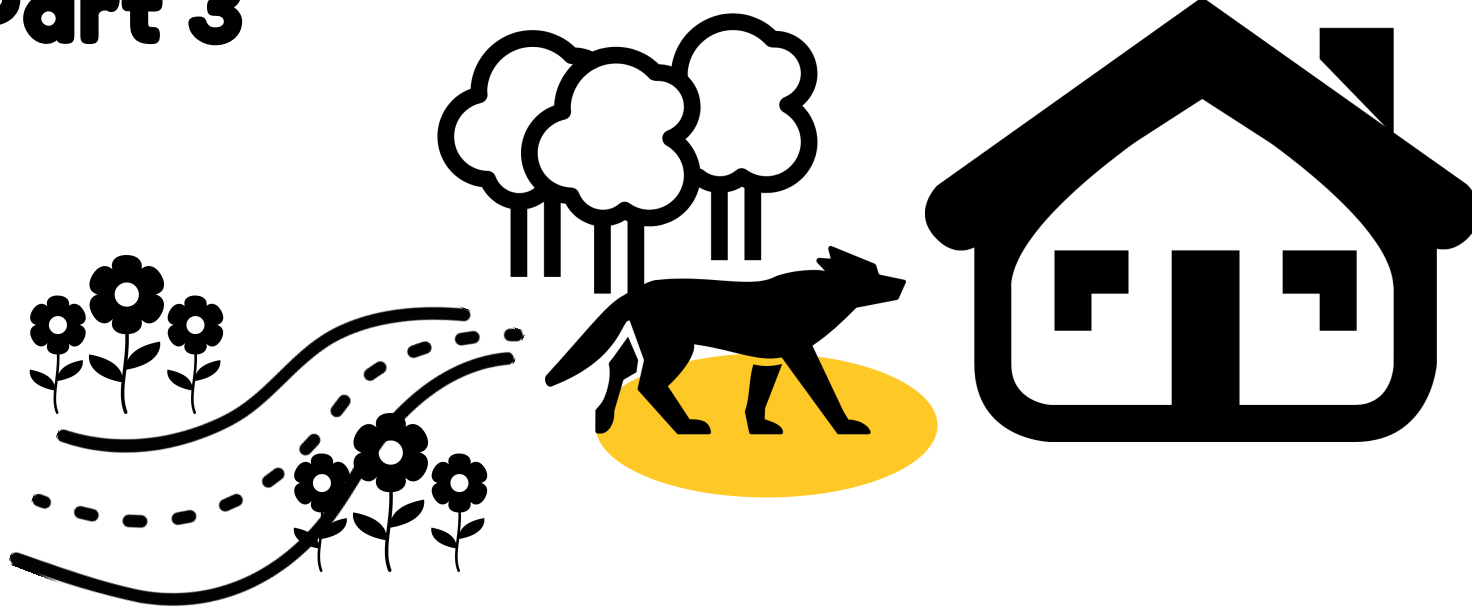
"Pick some flowers for her."

## Part 4



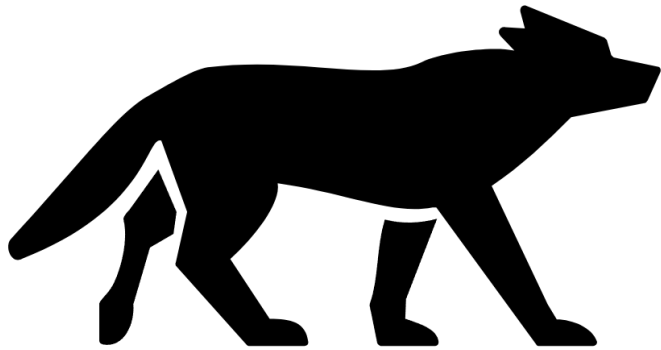
Little Red Riding Hood entered the house. She was happy to see her granny.

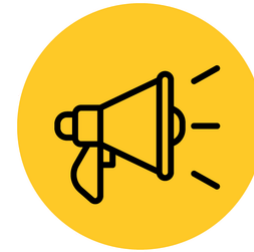
“Why do you have such big ears?”





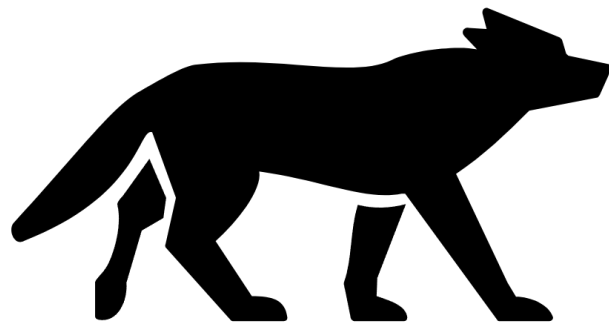
“So that I can hear you better”.

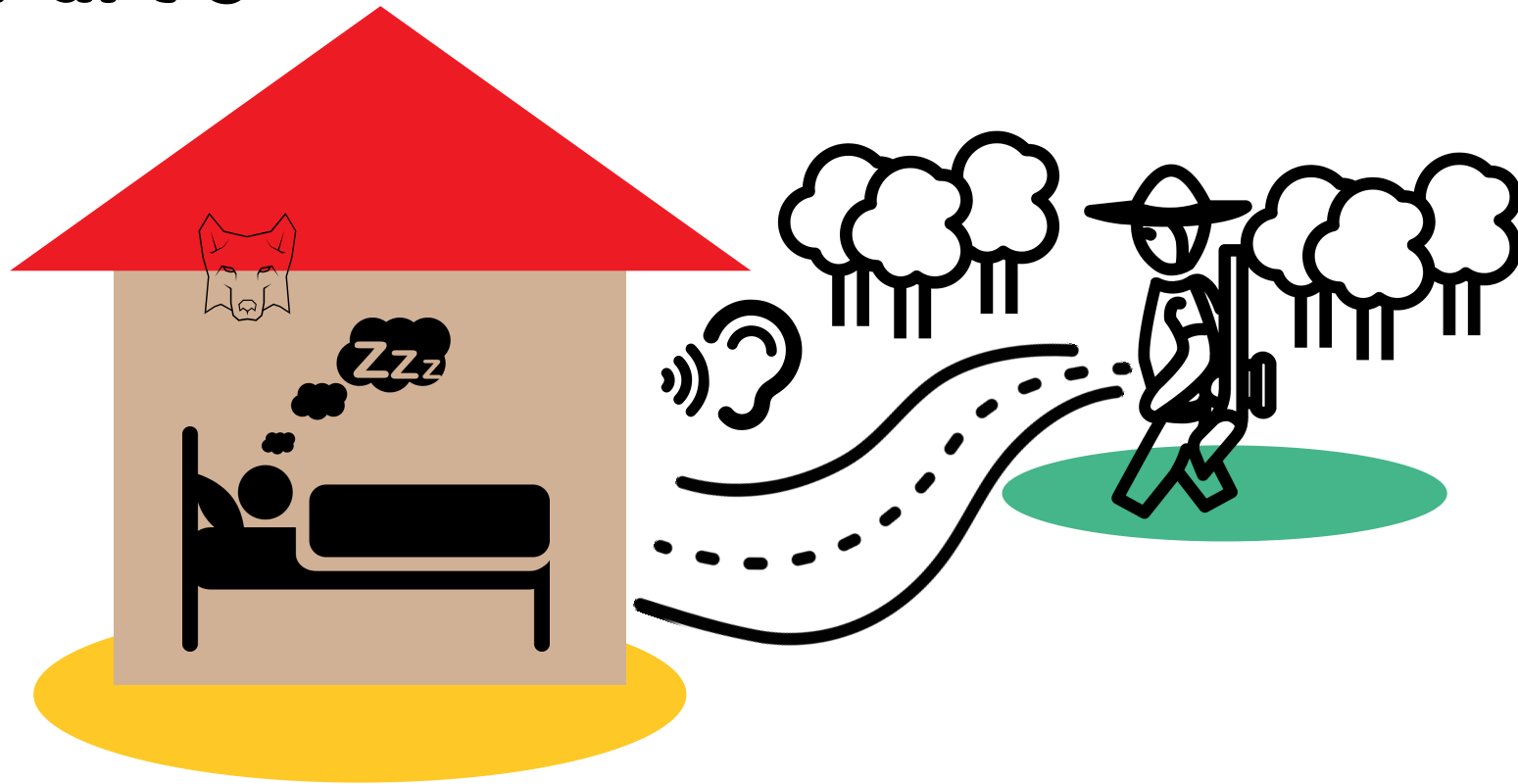
“So that I can eat you more easily”.



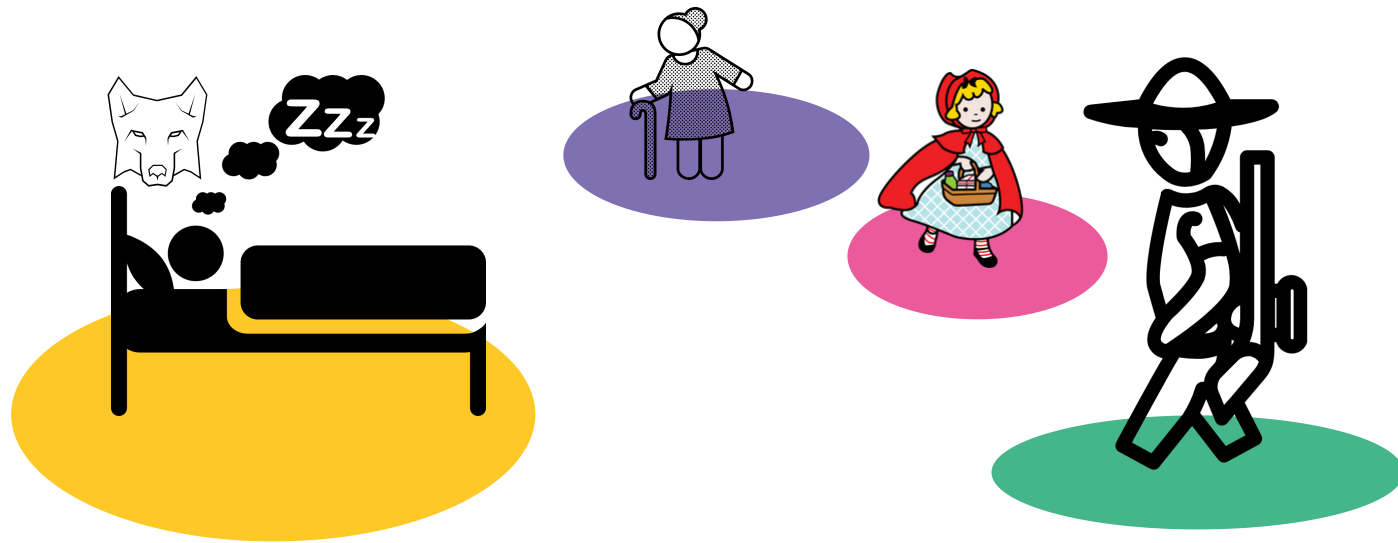


And suddenly, the wolf jumped out of the bed and ate Little Red Riding Hood. Tired after his meal, he fell asleep and snored loudly.

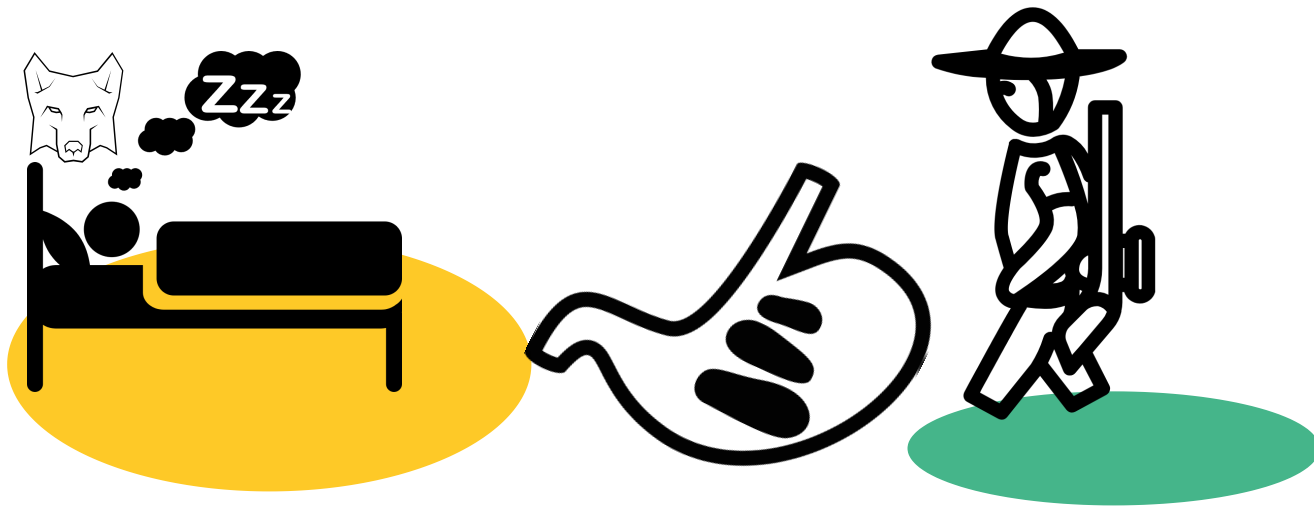
## Part 5



While he was sleeping, a hunter was walking by the house and heard loud snoring. He entered the house and saw the wolf.

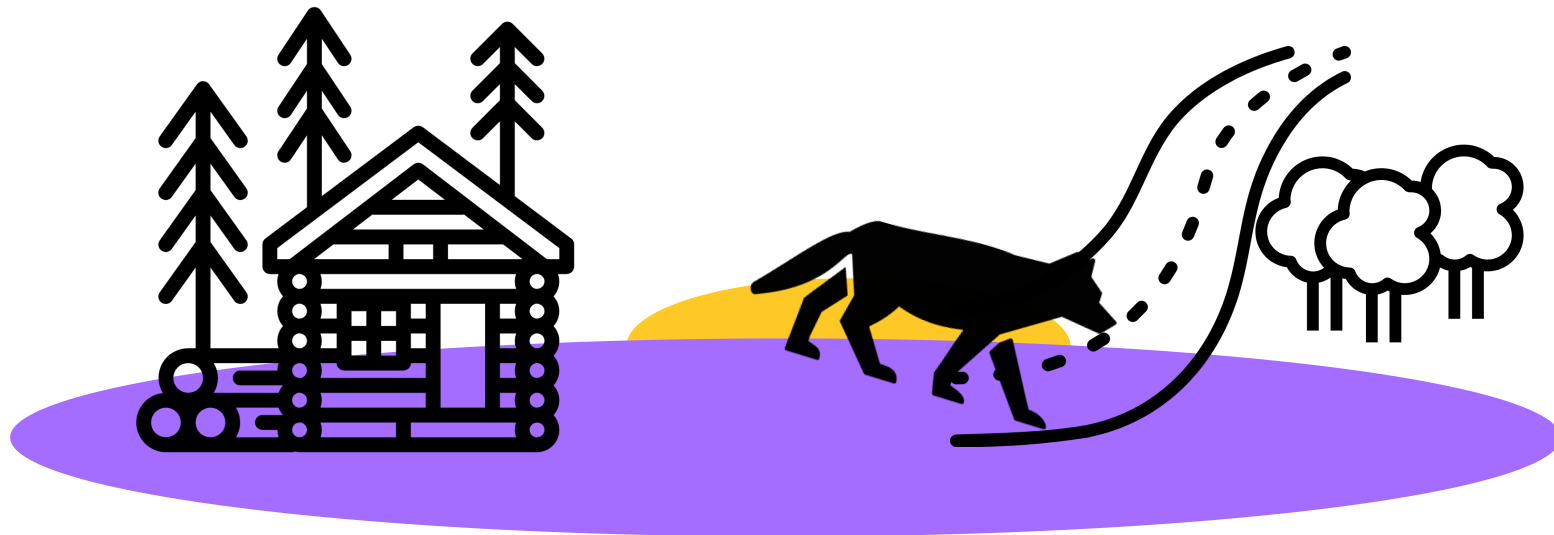


The hunter saw the huge wolf's belly and decided to open it. Little Red Riding Hood and her grandmother escaped from the wolf's stomach, they were free!
